

# When compliance and delivery collide, confidence and control are at risk

| 4 | <b>Sequencing gives way to obligation</b><br>Regulatory deadlines dictate timing rather than being absorbed into planned delivery.           | <b>The Impact</b><br>Change stacks up, raising complexity and heightening operational and delivery risk.                    |

These pressures persist because compliance authority and delivery control typically sit in different places, competing for the same time, people and attention.
